

Passé Composé Cheat Sheet

Le passé composé is the way to express the **past tense** in French. In English we say “I have studied for my test”. The same logic applies to French, “J’ai étudié pour mon examen.” The structure is as follows:

AVOIR (conjugated) + PAST PARTICIPLE

What is a past participle?

For regular verbs:

-ER: you simply drop the –er and add an **é**

Ex: J’ai travaillé

-IR: you simply drop the –ir and add an **i**

Ex: Nous avons fini

-RE: you simply drop the –re and add a **u**

Ex: Elles ont attendu

Helpful Vocabulary:

Hier – yesterday

samedi dernier – last Saturday

avant – before

après – after

pendant – during

d’abord – first

ensuite – then

finalement – finally

enfin – at last

déjà – already

ne....jamais - never

How do you put the passé composé in the negative?

ne + AVOIR (conjugated) + pas + PAST PARTICIPLE
